Oct. 24<sup>th</sup> and 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM on Sat. Oct. 31<sup>st</sup>. **Voters can vote at either of these locations. Or, you can vote on Election Day which is Tuesday November 3<sup>rd</sup>.**

If you have safety concerns about voting in person you can also vote by absentee mail In ballot. To use a mail in ballot you must file an application with the Rutherford County Board of Elections.
